Membership Fees 2019/2020

Our membership year runs from 1st October to 30th September.

If you join part way through the year, your membership fee reduces by 1/12th for each completed month of the year. E.g. if you join in March, it would be reduced by 5/12^{ths}.

Individual*	Single membership	£250.00
Dual*	Two members residing at same address	£375.00
Company*	Any business. Three access cards issued. Extra cards £100	£400.00
Start-Up Business	A business established for less than 2 years (proof required). Two access cards issued	£100.00
Country	Single member living more than 20 miles from the Club 'as the crow flies'	£ 75.00
Forces*	A member of the Armed Forces (UK or foreign) serving in the area for less than 3 years	£ 75.00
35 and Under*	A member who is 35 years of age or under (proof of age required)	£ 75.00

Member's Charge Account

For members in the categories marked*, we also require £240.00 per year to be paid into your member's account. If you join mid-year, we will again charge you the reduced pro-rata amount.

This money can be used to pay for food and drink in the Club. It must be used within the current membership year and is not refundable if not used.

When your vouchers have been used, we will send you monthly invoices for any items you have charged to your account. These must be settled within 30 days.

Some members prefer not to charge items to their account. That's fine. Once your vouchers have been used, you can pay in cash or by credit/debit card.
